What is CASPERR?

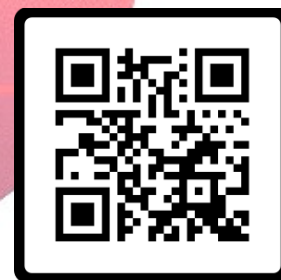
CASPERR is an **open-access research repository** dedicated to fostering open science and **enhancing the visibility and accessibility** of research data and outputs related to paramedicine, ambulance and emergency health services, and EMS in **Canada**.

What can I submit to CASPERR?

- ☑ Journal articles
- ☑ Textbooks and book chapters
- ☑ Posters and abstracts
- ☑ Educational materials
- ☑ Audio and video presentations
- ☑ Reports
- ☑ Study protocols, search strategies
- ☑ Theses and dissertations
- ☑ Data sets and supporting files with appropriate ethics approval

Why deposit in CASPERR?

- ☑ **Free to access** content without registration
- ☑ **One single access point** for all Canadian paramedicine research data and outputs
- ☑ **Greater dissemination and citation** of research data and outputs
- ☑ Alignment with **open science** policies
- ☑ **Accountability** and easy research impact tracking
- ☑ Ability to **assign permanent citeable identifiers** (DOIs) to all outputs and data
- ☑ Ability to **link related outputs and data**
- ☑ **Permanent, backed-up, secure copies**
